

## Phase One – Opening

Starting on May 18<sup>th</sup> here are the rules and guidelines we will be adhering to and enforcing.

USTA and State and Jefferson County Health Department (Jeffco) guidelines will be strictly adhered to. This includes:

### Jeffco/State Guidelines:

- All instructors/ staff will wear masks
- Participants are strongly encouraged to wear masks, particularly before and after play
- No more than 10 participants on the courts at one time

### USTA Guidelines

- Try to stay at least six feet apart from other players. Do not make physical contact with them (such as shaking hands or a high five).
- Consider not playing doubles at this time.
- Avoid touching your face after handling a ball, racquet or other equipment. Wash your hands promptly if you have touched your eyes, nose or mouth.
- Avoid sharing food, drinks or towels.
- Use your racquet/foot to pick up balls and hit them to your opponent. Avoid using your hands to pick up the balls.
- Stay on your side of court. Avoid changing ends of the court.
- Remain apart from other players when taking a break.
- If a ball from another court comes to you, send it back with a kick or with your racquet.

### Lakewood Park Tennis Center Guidelines:

- Tennis Hut will allow a max of **one** customer at a time – observing Social Distancing of 6ft minimum at all times.
- Will offer "**No Touch Lessons**" – where there is ZERO shared equipment.
  - Private and small groups less than 10. Again, no more than 10 on courts at one time.
  - Tennis Pro picks up the balls
  - All participants observe Social Distancing minimums of 6ft at all times.
- All instructors/ staff will wear masks
- Participants should wear masks before and after play.
- Singles play court reservations only. No doubles at this time. Singles players should purchase 2-cans of balls, 3 designated balls for each player.
- No cash. All reservations encouraged online or phone – to minimize interactions.
- All Tennis Play maintains strict social distancing at all times and during all change-overs.
- Customers plan to leave immediately afterwards (no socializing at the facility)
  - Customer may re-locate to a different, allowable section of Lakewood Park; away from the tennis area. (Some participants want to stretch after play)
- There will be no dry or wet grooming equipment or score trees on the courts.
- Customer will bring their own water. Water stations will not be available.
- Customers should bring their own mask. Customers are also encouraged to bring and use hand sanitizer.
- Please stay home if you are expecting any symptoms as listed by the CDC Guidelines.
- Please do not enter the courts if you have any symptoms or exposure risks as listed by the CDC Guidelines.
- Ball machine must be sprayed down by participant using the machine.
- All participants must read our rules and sign digitally.

### Booking Private and Private Group Lessons

- No more than 10 on all courts at one time
- Contact us with the days and times that you would like to book
- Arrive no more than 10 minutes before your lesson. Leave immediately following lesson.

- Plan to put a credit card on file under your LPTC account. Credit card payments will be recommended over other forms of payment.
- Do not pick up balls - staff will pick them up during/after your lessons

**Failure to comply with these rules and guidelines may result in LPTC staff and/or law enforcement asking you to leave the premises.**
