FORMAT

Seeding Round: Players are seeded based on their cumulative tiebreak tennis point standings. Players play one tiebreaker with each player on their court or in their grouping. (Courts scored evenly). Ladder Round: Top finishers from the seeding round (based on total points scored) move to the top court/group, second grouping to the second court, etc. Players will then play one tiebreaker with each player on their court or in their grouping. (Weighted court point scoring). Championship Round: Top finishers on each court from the Ladder Round move up a court/group and the bottom finishers move down a court/group. Players then play one tiebreaker with each player on their court or in their grouping. (Weighted court point scoring).
